ARENA FACILITY PROTOCOLS – ICE RENTALS (Last updated July 22, 2020)

GENERAL

- Coaches/Instructors must use the self-screening tool before coming to the facility. <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/> and must stay home when ill and are not allowed entry if they are ill with COVID-19 symptoms.
- Coaches/Instructors/Participants must be given information on social distancing protocols, hand washing, etc. <http://www.manitoba.ca/covid19/restoring/guidance.html>
- Coaches/Instructors/Participants must adhere to all guidelines as outlined in the Province's Team Sports and Other Recreational Activities Phase 3 Guidelines https://manitoba.ca/asset_library/en/proactive/2020_2021/restoring-safe-services-phase-3.pdf
- Coaches/Instructors will be expected to advise their participants that daily self-screening is required before attending the facility and they are prohibited from attending the camp/session if they have COVID-19 symptoms.
- **Maximum group size of 24 per session (10 participants & 1 instructor & 1 Safety Person per dressing room)**
- **ONLY TWO DRESSING ROOMS PER USER GROUP WILL BE AVAILABLE. A Coach/Instructor/Safety Person must be in the dressing room with the participants at all times. Dressing Rooms 1 and 2 will enter the ice surface at the front of the arena and Dressing Rooms 3 and 4 will enter at the rear of the arena**
- One Parents/Guardians/Spectators per Participant **is permitted** in the facility, but is not allowed in the dressing room. They will also be required to pass the Covid-19 screening questionnaire and add their name to the sign in sheet at the front desk.
- Only washroom facilities within the assigned dressing room may be used. Showers are not to be used at this time.
- Water fountains are not available at this time so participants should bring their own labeled water bottle(s).

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE

- Participants will not be allowed to enter the facility through the main doors until **30 minutes prior** to their ice time.
- Coaches/Instructors must provide a clear typed or legibly **printed** list which includes the names of all coaches/instructors/participants (copy of form attached) to the front Arena Attendant prior to any participants arriving.
- Upon arrival, the Arena Attendant will ask participants to use the hand sanitizer, ask screening questions, and then the participant will be signed in and directed to their dressing rooms where they should then wash their hands.
- Participants and Coaches/Instructors must follow designated pathways and remain in dressing room until the designated ice time and/or departure. Congregating or standing in hallways or common areas is not permitted at this time.
- When the participants are ready to leave the facility, the Participants will then be escorted out of the facility as a group by the trainers/coaches adhering to social distancing protocols.
- We ask that all users remove skates/equipment and leave the facility as quickly as possible so that the rooms can be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized
