

1. Purpose

- 1.1 To provide clear guidelines on sanctions provided by Ringette Manitoba.

2. General

- 2.1 All Full Members of Ringette Manitoba are deemed to be sanctioned upon registering and payment of fees to Ringette Manitoba.
- 2.2 Ringette Manitoba will not sanction any events with alcohol.
- 2.3 An Event Participation Form must be completed and submitted for any event to be sanctioned.

3. Tournaments

- 3.1 Tournaments will be sanctioned as per the Ringette Manitoba Tournament Policy.

4. Travel

- 4.1 Teams will receive a sanction for their activity scheduled by the tournament or event within Canada (games, skills comp, opening/closing ceremonies, skills competitions). Teams will not be covered for anything other than tournament participation (Accommodations, Meals, Travel, Team Activities, etc.).
- 4.2 Team travel out of the country and overseas may be covered but would require additional approvals, and costs. Any additional costs would be the responsibility of the team or individual applying.

5. Skills and Conditioning Camps

- 5.1 Skills and Conditioning Camps will be sanctioned as long as all individuals on the ice (participants and instructors) are current registered members of Ringette Manitoba.

6. Recruitment Events

- 6.1 Recruitment Events such as Come Try and Bring a Friend will be sanctioned for anyone seeking potential membership up to a maximum of three tries.

7. Exhibition Games

- 7.1 Exhibition Games will be sanctioned provided that both teams playing and all the players on those teams are registered with Ringette Manitoba and all officials are certified registered officials.
