
Organization refers to Ringette Manitoba

1. Purpose

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to ensure national enforcement and recognition of all disciplinary sanctions applied by the Organization and Members.

2. Application

- 2.1 This policy applies to all Members.
- 2.2 Sanctions, including suspensions and eligibility restrictions, will apply to all sanctioned and recognized activities of Ringette Manitoba and its Members. If any clarifications regarding the application of sanctions to Member activities are required they will be addressed by Ringette Manitoba or ITP.

3. Responsibilities

- 3.1 The Organization will:
- a) Provide copies of discipline and appeal summaries to Ringette Canada and to the Member(s) affected or impacted by the decision, as well as the Local Association(s) with which the Participant is affiliated;
 - b) for discipline decisions provided to Ringette Manitoba by Ringette Canada or by a Member, or by a Local Association, determine per the *Discipline and Complaints Policy* whether to initiate further action against the individual(s) named in the summary;
 - c) recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by Ringette Canada and/or a Member; and
 - d) Update its governing documents to reference the reciprocation procedures described herein, as well as in accordance with Ringette Canada's.
- 3.2 Members will:
- a) provide copies of discipline and appeal summaries involving Participants to Ringette Manitoba;
 - b) recognize and enforce the disciplinary sanctions imposed by Ringette Manitoba and/or Ringette Canada; and
 - c) update their governing documents and policies to reference the reciprocation procedures described herein.
